The mission of Ohio's Aging Eye Public Private Partnership is to implement a plan of action to address issues encompassing vision care and preservation, rehabilitation services, vision-related public health and policy, education and awareness, and research that impacts the quality of life for Ohio's seniors now and in the future.

Vision-Related Public Health & Policy

- ∞ Integrate adult vision messaging and strategies into state and local health improvement planning.
- ∞ Advocate for coverage of comprehensive vision care and rehabilitation services for adults in Medicaid and Medicare programs.
- Advocate for the development and expansion of comprehensive vision care and rehabilitation services within community health centers,
 including federally qualified health centers.
- ∞ Advocate for affordable health insurance coverage for early detection of disease and comprehensive vision care and rehabilitation services.

Education & Awareness

- Educate others in how they can provide access to vision care and rehabilitation services with their clients.
- Increase awareness about the growth of vision problems amongst Ohio's aging population.
- Support early detection and treatment efforts for chronic diseases that impact vision and eye health.

Research

- Support vision-related activities that promote awareness, collaboration and expansion of research.
- Support and advocate for inclusion of vision questions in Ohio and national data collection tools to provide outcome data on which to base statewide public health vision programming.

Vision Care and Preservation & Rehabilitation Services

- Support efforts that increase evidencebased vision screening practices as well as access to vision care and rehabilitation services.
- ∞ Promote best practices for seniors in maintaining healthy vision.
- Support efforts that eliminate health disparities in vision and rehabilitation services.
