Upon successful completion of the training, you will be nationally certified to provide adult vision screenings for three years and are eligible to receive FREE vision screening equipment including: Adult Risk Assessment and Registration Forms, Near and Distance Visual Acuity Charts and assorted educational vision resources and brochures.

**HealthyEyes Program:** enhances the services of Ohio's senior care and public health networks by providing information and access to prevention information, referral, and treatment resources for adult eye challenges.

After completing the HealthyEyes portion of the program, you will be able to provide your professional and consumer constituent base with facts and information about what they can do to prevent vision loss. You will receive a HealthyEyes Toolkit that contains a flash drive with many PowerPoint presentations, handouts, and material to support the presentations. This provides you with opportunity to be an advocate for eye healthy and safety!
