After attending the Adult Vision Screening Training Program, you will be able to:

Upon successful completion of the training and a practical assessment, you will be nationally certified to provide adult vision screenings for three years and may be eligible to receive vision screening equipment including: Adult Risk Assessment and Registration Forms, charts, and assorted educational vision resources and brochures. The HealthyEyes Program enhances the

services of Ohio’s health-care volunteers, senior care staff, and public health networks by providing access to prevention, referral, and treatment resources for adult eye challenges. After completing the HealthyEyes portion of the program, you will be able to provide facts and information to help prevent vision loss. You will receive a HealthyEyes Toolkit that with many PowerPoint presentations, handouts, and support materials. This training provides you with the opportunity to be an advocate for eye health.
